The village comprises of many attractive period houses, churches, a popular village pub/restaurant, a recreation ground and a Primary School that enjoys an outstanding reputation.






















Communications are excellent, with easy access to the M4 junction 12 at Theale and the M40 junction 6 at Lewknor. Didcot Parkway mainline railway station is only two miles away with a regular service to London Paddington in approximately 35/40 minutes, Oxford around 15 mins and Reading around 20 mins.

The A34, which is approximately four miles away, provides easy access to Newbury, Oxford and the M4 motorway.

Opposite the school is Hagbourne village hall used regularly for village events.

In 1996, 1999, 2003 and 2004 East Hagbourne was awarded the title of Best Kept Village in Oxfordshire. In 2009 the village was one of nine UK finalists in the Royal Horticultural Society's Britain in Bloom competition.
