Secure Gated Parking

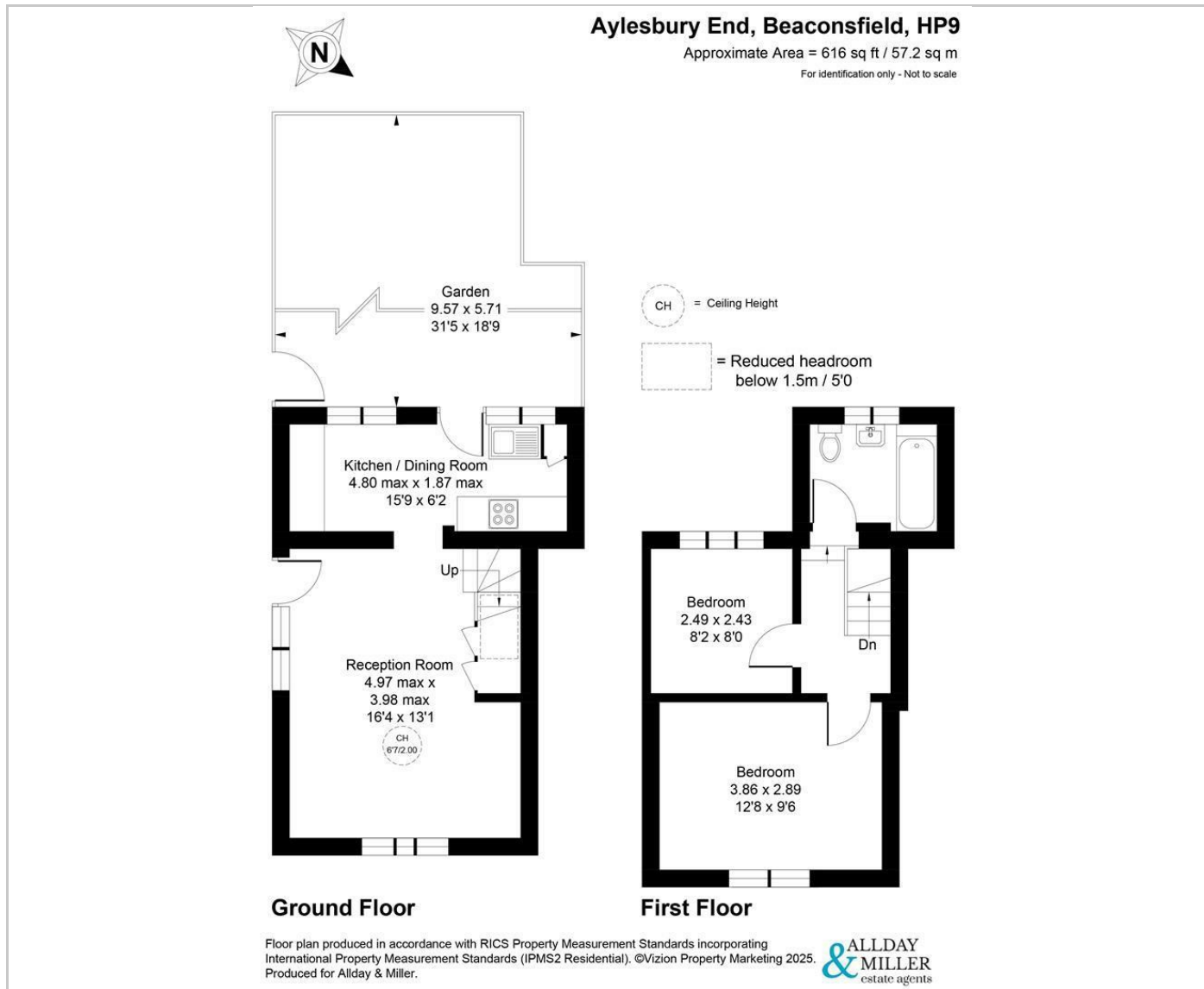
To the rear of the property, parking is available behind secure gates, offering both convenience and peace of mind. The space also benefits from an electric vehicle charging point, ideal for modern living.

Situation

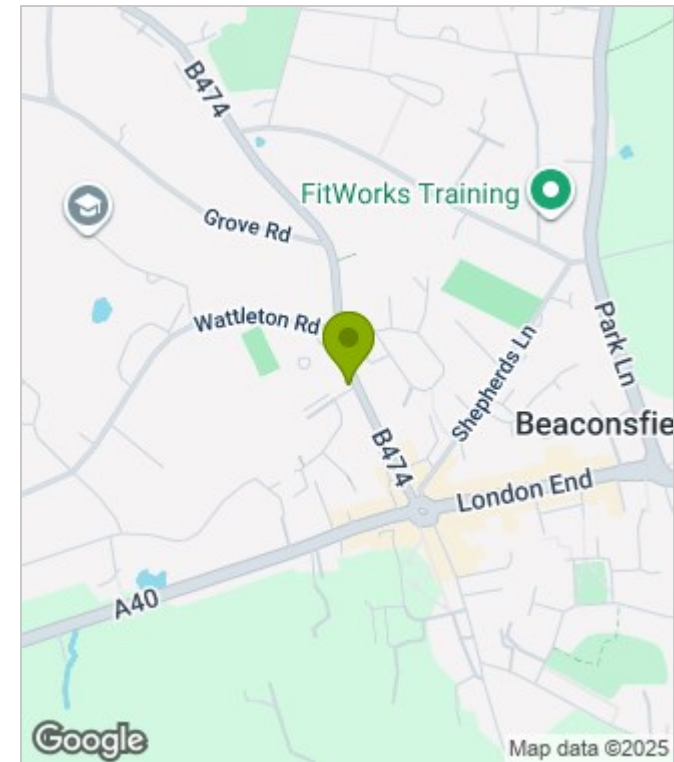

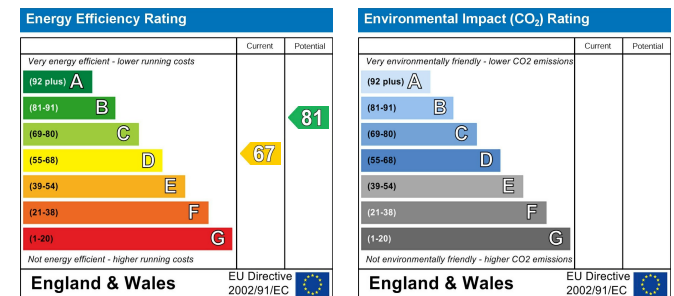
Floor Plans
