Beautifully presented and well proportioned Barratt 'Eco' home.

Open plan kitchen/dining space with fully refitted 'Schmidt' kitchen, with fully integrated appliances, two downstairs bedrooms and a bathroom.

At the first floor is a large reception/living room, with beautifully vaulted ceiling, light filled with full length window and door leading onto balcony overlooking allotments.

There is a master suite with build in wardrobes and en suite bathroom, plus another additional bedroom.

The rear garden is beautifully enclosed with two seating areas, a range of mature shrubs, plus a lawn area.

There are two allocated parking spaces.

'Eco Village' lifestyle with superb surroundings, and all the conveniences of modern day living - a great alternative to older developments!

The main Eco features of the Hanham Hall properties is they are incredibly well insulated SIP walls (including soundproofing on party walls) and floors, with a mechanical ventilation & heat recovery unit (MHRU) so you don't lose any heat unless you open a window. Solar panels on the roof cut down electricity bills. The rainwater harvesting (RWH) system from the roofs uses 'grey water' for your washing machine to help reduce your water bill. A SUDS system is designed to collect surface water from roads and pathways and channel it through swales into the wildlife pond by the playgrounds. The property also benefits from air conditioning on the ground and first floor.

the location

Set on the edge of the cycle path, there is a range of good local amenities at nearby Hanham high street and the retail park at Longwell Green. With lovely walks over the Hanham hills and nearby Conham river park, Gover Road playing fields are also on the doorstep, Hanham Common is 1/2 mile away. This property also has lovely views from it's balcony at the front across the allotments and Hanham hill to the rear. Bristol 3.9 miles Bath 8.6 miles
