Set within the attractive South Shropshire town of Clun, and enjoying far-reaching views towards the surrounding hills, The Sun Barn is a highly individual property offering exceptional versatility and considerable character. Constructed in 1994 using vernacular materials that reflect the local architectural heritage, the property combines distinctive design with practical and adaptable accommodation.

Clun is one of South Shropshire's most picturesque and historic small towns, surrounded by beautiful countryside and well known for its strong sense of community and unspoilt setting. The property is well placed to enjoy the tranquillity of rural living whilst remaining within convenient driving distance of Craven Arms, Ludlow and Shrewsbury, all of which provide an extensive range of amenities and services.

On entering the property, an impressive reception hall creates an immediate sense of space and individuality. The ground floor offers three generously proportioned bedrooms, including a principal bedroom with en suite bathroom, together with the main family bathroom. The kitchen is smartly appointed and opens directly onto the enclosed courtyard garden.

The first floor is a particularly striking feature of the house. Here, an impressive living room is filled with natural light from expansive windows and offers a highly adaptable space with areas suited to dining, music, reading, study and relaxation. This floor can be accessed either by staircase or via the Stiltz lift and also benefits from a cloakroom with WC. The layout provides a wonderful sense of openness and flexibility, equally suited to everyday living and entertaining.

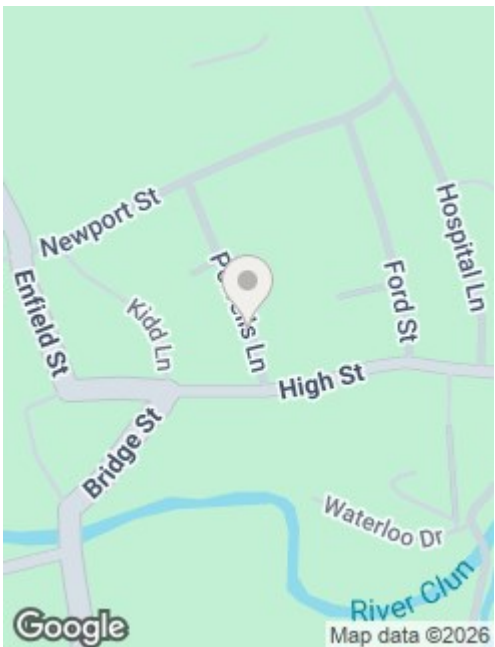
A further staircase rises from the study area to a landing serving the impressive balcony gallery. From this elevated position, there is a dramatic outlook over the principal living space, emphasising the scale and architectural character of the property.

Outside, the property benefits from driveway parking for two vehicles and a garage with electric door. The enclosed courtyard garden provides a private and sheltered setting for entertaining, alfresco dining or simply enjoying the peaceful surroundings.
