An imposing home that is uniquely positioned at the highest point of the Haymills Estate with far-reaching views from the rear towards Central London. The property has a beautifully landscaped garden extending to around 90 ft and ample off street parking.



The property consists of a dining room, separate kitchen and a large double reception room with door opening out to the impressive rear garden including some exercise equipment.

Upstairs are three double bedrooms and three modern bathrooms, one of which is en suite. There is also a large loft space. There is also generous off-street parking for several cars at the front of the house.

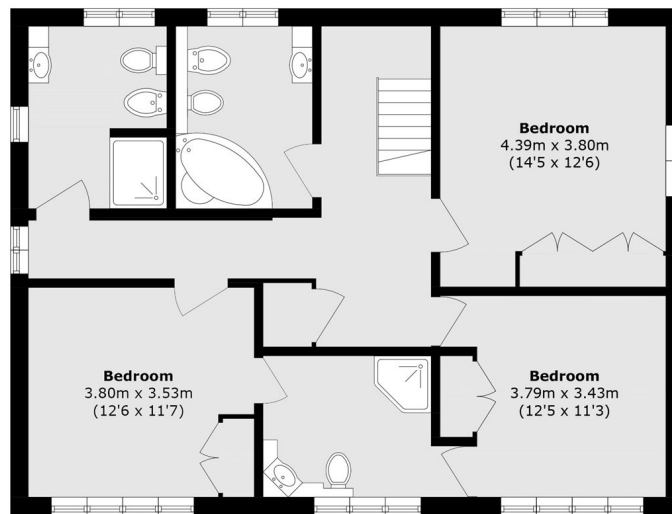
The house also has exciting potential to increase in size. Planning permission is in place for a scheme that would increase the property to approximately 3,000 sq ft. As works under the permission have commenced, the permission is understood to remain active without the usual expiry date, allowing the remaining works to be completed in the future.

The property has the benefit of being offered with no onward chain.

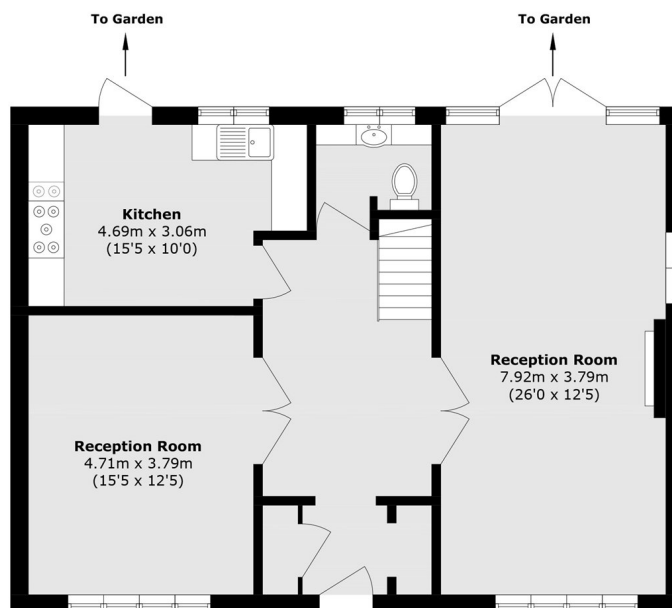
